

## Did You Know. . .

*DRESSER TRAP ROCK INC.*, is one of Wisconsin's oldest industries. It was built in 1914, although trap rock has been mined here since 1855. The name comes from the kind of rock being crushed here -- "trap" rock -- meaning dark, fine-grained igneous rock. Trap rock is actually altered basalt, or volcanic (non-porous) rock with irregular seams. It is the hardest known rock in North America. The quality of trap rock deposits varies, in the same manner other mineral deposits vary. The Dresser deposit is the hardest concentration of this basalt-type rock in America -- so hard that boulders from Dresser Trap Rock were shipped to Maryland for use by NASA in testing drills used on the moon probe.

Today, Dresser Trap Rock is used extensively in bituminous and concrete applications, erosion and ice control, road construction, roofing products, landscaping and as ballast for many different railroads throughout the Midwest.
